



Q1 Which of the following statements describes your relationship to the City of Cambridge? Please select all that apply.




Q2 How many years have you either lived in or operated a business in the City of Cambridge?







Q3 The City provides programs and services to all ages. Please indicate what age categories are within your household? Please select all that apply.




Q4 Do you feel that you understand how your tax dollars are used?







Q9 What cost should the user pay for these types of services and what portion should be subsidized through property taxes? Select the option you agree with the most.




Question options
