Comprehensive Public Notice Policy

Council Meeting of September 17, 2024



Legislative Requirement

- Section 270(1)(4) of the *Municipal Act*, 2001 requires municipalities to adopt and maintain a policy with respect to the circumstances in which the municipality shall provide notice to the public, and if notice is to be provided, the form, manner and times notice shall be given.
- In 2023 Metroland Media Group ceased the print publication of 71 community newspapers across the province, including The Cambridge Times.
- There still exists a legislative requirement to post certain notices in a print newspaper (i.e. Cemeteries Act, etc.).
- Since the discontinuation of the print publication of The Cambridge Times, staff have been using The Waterloo Region Record to satisfy current newspaper publication requirements.



Direction to Staff

 January 30, 2024 Meeting of the Planning – Statutory Public Meeting Committee, the following direction was provided to staff:

THAT the City Clerk work with the Chief Planner on notice provisions and options to increase awareness for citizens of public meetings;

AND THAT the City Clerk and Chief Planner report back to Council on options to increase the notice provisions for planning applications as part of the Public Notice Policy report that is forthcoming;

AND THAT the City ensure that the same notice be provided to all occupants, tenants and residents within the required notification area in addition to the registered property owners for anything effective immediately.



Process Followed

- Municipal scans of existing Public Notice policies and drafting of policy.
- Municipal consultation on planning notice circulations and current practices.
- In depth review of the public notice requirements in various legislation.
- Internal consultations with various Divisions and internal leadership teams.
- One-on-one staff consultation, as required.
- Consultation with Council Members.



Planning Notice Research Findings

- Several municipalities have enhanced planning notifications above and beyond the current legislated requirements including:
 - Extension of 120 metre legislated circulation radius;
 - Including tenants of multi-residential buildings in circulations;
 - Improvements to on-site signage for development applications; and
 - Roll out of dedicated public notice webpages.



Planning Policies

- Planning Act establishes a minimum 120 metre circulation radius requirement for giving of Public Notice for Official Plan and Zoning By-law Amendments.
- Nothing in Provincial Policy Statement (2020) or A Place to Grow (2020) that would prevent expansion of circulation radius beyond 120 metres.
- Changes to the City's notice provisions would require an Official Plan Amendment, including the holding of a public meeting under the Planning Act.
 - ➤ The Official Plan sets out the timing, format and, method of how notice will be provided and currently stipulates a radius of 120 m for Official Plan and Zoning By-law Amendments.
 - > Removal of requirement to provide notice through newspaper



Current Issues with Notices

- Traditional notice is provided by letter and envelope method, contains a lot of technical jargon and other details not easily understood by residents.
- Tenants are not receiving notices as they can't open the owner's mail.
- Circulation radius for Zoning By-law and Official Plan Amendment applications (120 metres) is not reaching enough of the community surrounding a proposed development.
- Notices are not easily found on City website once they are circulated nor are they posted in another publicly accessible location.
- There are no standardized templates for public notice or guidelines around notice which
 results in inconsistencies in how public notice is provided, i.e. technical jargon, too much
 text, confusing information, not accessible, not meeting corporate standards (logo use),
 etc.



Proposed Notice Methods

- Establish a new postcard format for most public notices, which is more attractive, easier to read and recognizable (design for Planning notices to be used for on site signage as well).
 - > Tenants will able to read the postcard even if addressed to owner.
- Standardized templates for staff to use when drafting notice.
- Door hanger templates for Environmental Services. Operations and Emergency Services to use when providing more time sensitive notice that is dependent on schedules of contractors, etc.
- Colour coding system for notices based on type of notice being provided.
- Centralized public notice webpage where all notices would be posted and notice board at City Hall where physical copies of notices can be posted.

Notice Templates – Door Hanger **Planting Instructions**

- · Plant tree on your private property, at the side or back of your home
- Call or click before you dig OntarioOneCall.ca
- Trees like space. It's recommended you plant yours at least 6 metres from buildings, structures or other trees
- Dig a hole as deep as the pot and 1 ½ times as wide as the pot
- Carefully remove tree from pot to avoid damage



- Loosen lower roots
- Place tree in hole and place soil back around the tree, avoiding air gaps
- · Plant the tree level with surrounding soil
- · Place a fibre mat around the tree to prevent weeds
- Water thoroughly once per week for several weeks



Restoration Policies and Procedures

The City will make a reasonable effort to complete the work in a timely manner. Timing will vary based on time of year and weather conditions.

Driveway

If driveway restoration work is required, the City will only restore with white brushed concrete or asphalt material. The City may be able to share the cost of restoring your coloured, stamped, or exposed concrete driveway. To discuss this option, call Service Cambridge for more details.

Lawn

Damage to your lawn (on either public or private property) will be repaired by the City with sod or topsoil and seed.

Walkway

Contact Service Cambridge to discuss impacts to private walkways.

Gardens or Landscaping

Contact Service Cambridge to discuss gardens or landscaping on private property. Note that these are not permitted in the public right-of-way and will not be restored unless an easement or encroachment agreement has been previously established.

All boulevard turf grass and vegetation restoration work will be completed in accordance with By-Law 21-050 (Corridor Management).

Concrete - Driveway or Walkway

Please allow up to 5 days for completion and curing of curb, sidewalk, and/or driveway ramp.

Asphalt – Driveway or Walkway

Upon completion of concrete, any asphalt restoration work will then take place.

Grass Seed or Sod

Sod crew will follow asphalt and concrete crews to repair any damage with either seed or sod to the grass area. Please help us by watering.

Parking

An exemption for overnight parking on the road may be requested by calling 519-740-4613 ext. 4217.
