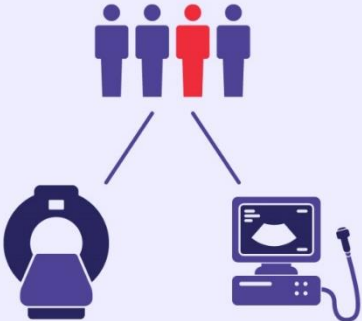

Thank You For Helping To Raise \$5M For Spotlight MRI

- Because of our Community of donors, we've exceeded our \$5M goal to bring a new MRI to CMH.
- The City of Cambridge was instrumental in helping to launch the campaign with a \$100,000 gift, inspiring others to give. Then you helped us close out the campaign 8 months early, with another \$100,000 gift.
- A new MRI is coming to CMH, bringing improved imaging clarity for accurate diagnosis and local access to MRI. This means that patients can begin treatments and recovery sooner, close to home.

essential to patient comfort.**

New and replacement equipment is needed to provide support and comfort throughout the patient journey.

A spotlight on equipment essential to patient comfort

Items like stretchers, treatment chairs, vital signs monitors, portable x-ray units, and replacement beds, including specialized birthing beds, empower our healthcare team and ensure patients are comfortable during procedures and stays at our Hospital.

THIS INCLUDES EQUIPMENT SUCH AS:	COST/UNIT
12 replacement beds/year	\$16,000
12 mattresses/year	\$5,000
18 procedural stretchers for various departments	\$5,500
4 treatment chairs for medical program	\$1,800
7 operating room tables	\$100,000
8 anesthesia gas machines for surgery	\$90,000
1 new birthing bed	\$40,000
1 wheelchair washer for environmental services	\$47,000
1 floor cleaning scrubber	\$21,000
4 new ventilators for ICU	\$61,000
5 gastroscopes/colonoscopes for endoscopy	\$35,000
