Proposed Budget Amendment for Council to Consider:

THAT the installation of a new half-court basketball net & a new neighbourhood playground structure on city owned land in the undeveloped natural lands area located off Contestoga Boulevard and behind Lena Crescent, be added to the 2026 Capital Budget;

AND THAT the cost of the court and net (estimated at \$50,000), and cost of the playground structure (estimated in the range of \$150,000 to \$250,000), be drawn from the Capital Works Reserve;

AND THAT any funds brought forward through fundraising & sponsorships for the project be put back into the Capital Works Reserve

Rationale for Proposed Amendment:

The Lena Crescent neighbourhood was constructed without a City park and is in need of one as residents currently have to cross busy Can Amera Parkway to access park amenities. Park amenities in this area will benefit local children and teenagers and will give seniors somewhere to take their grandchildren when they visit. 
