

Riverside Dam December 2, 2021 Council Meeting





- In 2008 it was observed that the south control structure of the main dam was in very poor condition requiring emergency repair
- As a condition of approval the MNR required that the City complete a MCEA to determine a more permanent long-term solution
- Following the repair work, a 2009 structural evaluation of the dam concluded general conformance with the Ontario Dam Safety Guidelines
- A structural inspection was completed in 2018 and a subsequent visual inspection in 2020 that did not identify any material change in condition of dam.



- The construction cost estimate to rebuild has grown since the 2018 MCEA from \$6.2M to \$15.2M due to a combination of:
 - MCEA accuracy <u>+</u> 30%
 - Construction industry inflation over 4 years
 - Additional Minister conditions
- The MCEA also contemplated both naturalization and passive management approaches
- Given this project is funded through debt, this Report provides an option to initiate the passive management approach in order to provide financial flexibility.
