The Pinebush Monoliths Project: Vision for Community Pride and Sustainable Innovation

1. "Why":

Currently, the structures at Pinebush are uninspired. They represent a missed opportunity to create a "gateway" for Cambridge. Many local families have expressed a desire for a community—landmark that makes us proud to call Cambridge—home.

This proposal is a catalyst for the City to enter **formal discussions** with **Home Depot** regarding a potential sponsorship of the Pinebush Monoliths. Given Home Depot's commitment to community building, this project presents an "adopt-a-landmark" opportunity. A partnership would offset municipal costs while providing Home Depot with a high-visibility, legacy project that demonstrates their investment in the aesthetic and cultural growth of the city.

3. Sustainability & Cost Efficiency
