BY-LAW 26-023

Being a By-law to amend Schedule B of By-law 23-050 of The Corporation of the City of Cambridge

WHEREAS The City of Cambridge enacted By-law 23-050, being a By-law to establish an Administrative Penalty System for violations of by-laws within the City of Cambridge;

AND WHEREAS the Council for The Corporation of the City of Cambridge considers it desirable and necessary to amend various City by-laws to designate the provisions of the By-laws, pursuant to the Administrative Penalty By-law 23-050;

AND WHEREAS the Council for The Corporation of the City of Cambridge considers it desirable to enforce and seek compliance with the designated by-laws, or portions of those by-laws, through the Administrative Penalty System;

NOW THEREFORE The Council of The Corporation of the City of Cambridge enacts as follows:

1. That by-law 23-050, as amended, is hereby amended by deleting Schedule "B" and replacing it with the following Schedule "B" attached hereto.
