Hello,

My family and I live at [REDACTED]. Our home is directly adjacent to the Kenley Lane walkway. We would ask that council keep this walkway open to the public, make repairs to the collapsing retaining wall, and do essential repairs to the existing steps and handrails. This should allow the walkway to continue to be used for the foreseeable future, and would be a cheaper alternative to complete reconstruction. Closing the walkway would be a significant impediment to students who use the walkway to walk to Southwood School from Salisbury Ave, and for local residents who walk to Westgate Plaza. Closing it would increase the number of people making short trips in automobiles, undermining the city's commitment to reducing greenhouse gas emissions.
