

River Rd Secondary Plan and Zoning By-law Amendment – Recommendation
July 27, 2021 Special Council Meeting



Background:

- The City and consulting team has been completing and land use and servicing study for the River Rd. area.
- The study was initiated in 2019 in response to growth pressure through infill redevelopment of existing large residential lots in the area.
- Multiple formal and informal public consultation opportunities have occurred through the study process, including a statutory public meeting on April 27, 2021
- Tonight staff is recommending approval of a number of amendments to the City's policies and by-laws in order to complete the study.
- The City's consultant, Ute Maya-Giambattista, will give an overview of the study following these introductory remarks.

Secondary Plan:

 AND THAT Cambridge Council recommends approval of Official Plan Amendment No. 47 (River Road Secondary Plan) to the City of Cambridge Official Plan;

Staff Recommendations:

Zoning By-law Amendment:

- AND THAT Cambridge Council amends the Zoning By-law (Attachment No. 2 – Recommended Zoning By-law Amendment) for the River Rd. Neighbourhood;
 - The staff recommended amendment would permit singles, semidetached and triplex dwellings on large lots along River Rd.
 - An alternative amendment is included for Council consideration (Attachment No. 3) which would permit single detached dwellings only along River Rd.
 - * Note that both amendments have been updated to permit single detached dwellings on a private condominium road for the R5 zone.

AND THAT Cambridge Council amends the site plan control bylaw to include properties fronting on River Rd;
